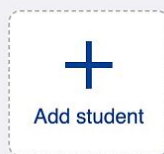
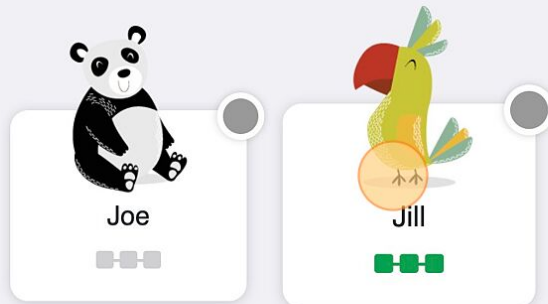


How to Remove a Presenting Problem

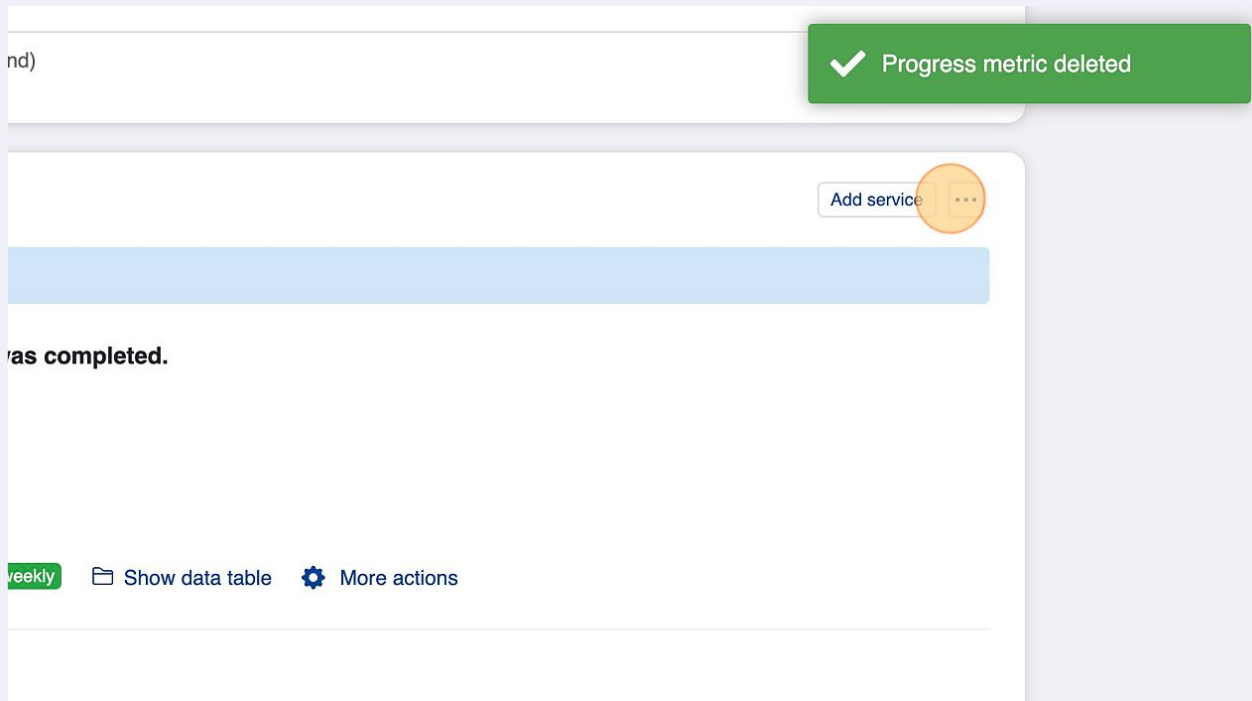
